

## Stalmine-with-Staynall Parish Council

Minutes of the meeting of Monday 23 January 2012 at the Village Hall, Stalmine

**Present:** Cllrs M J Jackson (Chairman), Mrs D Anderson, Ms P Andrews, K Jenkinson, W McCann

**Apologies:** Miss A McCann,

**Declarations of Interest:** Cllr Jackson declared a personal interest by way of family friendship with a potential website provider and in the Halite Energy Group application by way of land tenancy and business. Cllr McCann declared an interest in the halite application by way of land ownership and business interest.

**Minutes:** to receive the minutes of the meeting of 9 January 2012 as a correct record:

**(121)(2011/12) Resolved:** Cllr Jenkinson proposed the minutes as a correct record.

### Proposed Website

Members had had an opportunity to see a potential website for the Parish Council and were made aware of the possible costs.

**(122)(2011/12) Resolved:** that the Clerk continues negotiations and looks into the possibility of any grant aid.

### Planning

#### *Application*

12.00015.ful — erection of one agricultural/livestock building on land adjacent to Staynall Lane / New Road, Stalmine-with-Staynall, FY6 9DT.

Members considered the above application and thought the proposal was overbearing, could give rise to smells and spoil the visual amenity. Members doubted the land could support the proposed number of animals and noted the current buildings were underused.

**(123)(2011/12) Resolved:** that Wyre Borough Council be informed that the Parish Council was opposed to the application on the lines indicated.

Halite Energy Group Ltd — Proposed underground gas storage facility at Preesall

Members discussed the proposal and decided to make representations to the Infrastructure Planning Commission (IPC) on the basis they would be sending a fuller statement of objection later in the process.

**(124)(2011/12) Resolved:** the Clerk registers the Council's views with the IPC.

### Diamond Jubilee Celebrations

Members discussed the possibility of celebrating the Queen's Diamond Jubilee and decided an afternoon and evening of events based around the village hall on Saturday 2 June 2012 might be appropriate, and that a sub-committee of three members, comprising the vice-chairman and two others, should be set up to plan the event.

**(125)(2011/12) Resolved:** that a sub-committee be set up to organise a celebratory event for Saturday 2 June 2012.
