

Clerk's report (for information only)

- The official Parish Council notice board – Clerk contacted Geoff Gornall regarding making necessary repairs. Geoff “will have a look & be in touch”
- Clerk contacted Sim Lane-Dixon from LCC on 28.05.12 regarding the general condition of Keepers Lane & Higher Lane, Barnacre & raised concerns for cyclists & motorcyclists on Dimples Lane, in particular the stretch of road from the Dimples Lane bridge upto the Calder House Lane junction. Response from Sim Lane-Dixon as follows: “Thank you for your email and information on a number of specific roads. We are at present looking at roads which may be considered for inclusion within next year's programme (subject to availability of funding) I may not be able to include these at this late stage but some may already have been included for consideration. Once we have discussed the draft programme draft list I will let you know where they stand.
- Clerk wrote to planning regarding issues raised in the May meeting at Brooklands, Bruna Hill. Response as follows: “1.As you correctly state application 11/00802/FUL for the creation of hardstanding was refused and I have written and formally requested that the hardstanding be removed. If this is not carried out within the timescale I requested (28 days) letter sent a week ago, then I will serve an Enforcement Notice. 2. Application 11.00585/FUL was granted for the erection of the timber tower. The applicant would have 28 days per calendar year to use the land for clay pigeon shooting which a right permitted under the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995. 3. There is no formal permission required to park ‘ones’ helicopter within the grounds. I will let you know nearer the time the timescale and details of the Enforcement Notice re the hardstanding”.
- Clerk responded to the email from Alan Wallbank regarding planting a tree within the Parish to commemorate the Queen’s Jubilee giving locations of 2 possible places where a tree could be planted. 1. In the open space area by the bridge on Castle Lane and 2. To replace a dead tree at Parkhead Lane where the lane meets with Strickens Lane. These locations were identified by 2 Councillors.
- Clerk put forward the following ideas she received for funding from “shaping your neighbourhood” initiative; Landscaping of area which corners both Bonds & Castle Lane, bus stop on Bonds Lane, new Parish noticeboard, maintenance work on Calder Vale War Memorial & Barnacre Village Hall refurbishment (decorating & new flooring required) These ideas were discussed with Councillor David Williams who will represent ward Calder at a meeting on 4th July & the 2 projects best suited to the “pot of money” available would be the landscaping &/or the refurbishment of the memorial hall. As the other suggestions were of benefit to the community, these 2 seemed to fit most. Following the meeting on 4th July Councillor Williams confirms that the project most fitting to take forward for the ward would be the refurbishment of the memorial hall. More to be discussed at the July meeting.
- Clerk contacted Carl Green at Wyre on 28.05.12 regarding Strickens Lane signs (promised over 12 months ago) Awaiting response. Chased this on Monday 11.06.2012, left another message. Clerk did manage to speak to Carl Green on Monday 2nd July, passing on Councillor John Kellett’s details as the main point of contact on this.
