





# PREVENTATIVE HEALTH CARE FOR YOUR PET



At Isle Valley Vets we encourage good preventative healthcare programmes for your pets. In addition to regular vaccinations we also advise and administer flea and worming treatments.




## FLEA TREATMENT



Fleas spend more time in the carpet and environment than on the pet, so it is important to have a routine anti flea regime to prevent an infestation. If you have an infestation it can be very hard to clear. The best way to prevent this from happening is to regularly treat your pets with an anti flea medication all year round. Isle Valley Vets recommend the use of topical anti parasitical treatments such as Frontline Combo Spot-On, Advocate Bravecto or Seresto flea collars.




## USING FRONTLINE ON DOGS



Frontline Combo Spot On can be used on dogs from eight weeks of age. It should be applied once every eight weeks for flea prevention. If treating for ticks it should be applied every four weeks. Frontline spray can be used on puppies from two days old. It should be applied every three months.




## USING FRONTLINE ON CATS



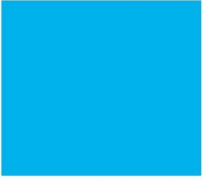
Frontline Combo Spot On can be used from eight weeks of age. It should be applied every four - five weeks. Frontline Spray can be used on kittens from two days old and should be applied every two months.



## ADVOCATE



Another flea treatment that Isle Valley Vets recommend is Advocate spot on, which also treats some mites, roundworms and lungworm. It is a spot on treatment and should be applied to both cats and dogs once a month.



## **BRAVECTO**

Bravecto comes in a tablet form for dogs and a spot on for cats it prevents fleas and ticks and one treatment lasts for 3 months.



## **SERESTO FLEA COLLAR**

Seresto is an innovative flea and tick collar. It kills fleas and repels ticks for up to 8 months in dogs and cats.



## **WORMING YOUR PET**

Most worms live in your pet's intestines, feeding on the contents of the gut or the blood. Worms can cause illness, weight loss, poor condition, diarrhoea and vomiting and can, in extreme cases, lead to death. One particular roundworm can also cause blindness in people.



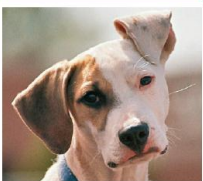
## **RESPONSIBLE PET OWNERS SHOULD WORM THEIR PETS EVERY THREE MONTHS.**

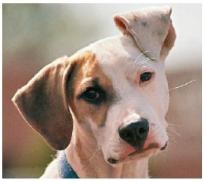
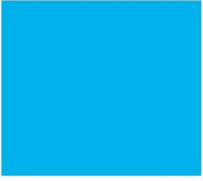
Isle Valley Vets recommend the use of Milbemax tablets. Milbemax is a multi wormer treating round worm, tape worm, heart worm and lung worm. Milbemax should be administered every three months in both cats and dogs.



Other worming treatments recommended by Isle Valley Vets are:

- Advocate – a wormer which also treats fleas and mites. However it does not treat tapeworm.
- Drontal – a wormer that treats all worms apart from heart and lung worms.
