

MICROCHIPPING

As of April 2016 it became law that all dogs MUST be microchipped and all Contact details held on the microchip database kept up to date. Currently there is no law in place for cats being microchipped, however Isle Valley strongly recommend that ALL cats should be.

In cats, dogs and rabbits the chip is inserted into the loose skin at the back of the neck. In tortoises, for example, it is inserted into the leg. It can be done at any age and should last the pet's lifetime. Once done you can relax knowing that your pet is always identifiable and always traceable to you.

If you wish to have your pet microchipped simply contact us to make an appointment. If you are attending the surgery for a routine check up or vaccination why not ask if your pet can be microchipped at the same time.
