Stagecoach

Raised the speed of the 89 and 89H coming into Smallwood Hey from Hooles Lane, the letter has been passed to Stagecoach Merseyside, rather than Stagecoach Cumbria and North Lancashire, as they are responsible for this route. Stagecoach is to have a word with the drivers concerned and ensure they adhere to the speed limit of 30MPH. It's a shame that he thinks we live in Piling!!
